Varsity baseball spring trip to J.M. Tate  
High School- Cantonment (Pensacola)  
FL - March 28 - April 3, 2010

The dates are set. The varsity team along with Coach Bisceglia and his staff will have hired A-1 Luxury Coach to provide transportation from Coral Reef High School to JM Tate High School in Pensacola to participate in the 17th annual Aggies National Baseball Tournament beginning Monday, March 29 and ending on Friday, April 2.

**The travel fee is set right now at \$125 per player.** This fee is payable to Coral Reef High School and will be deposited into the baseball field trip account to help offset the cost of transportation and lodging. It must be paid **by March 15.**

I also require that each player bring at least **\$120 for meals.** This \$120 will be collected prior to traveling. None of this money will be used for anything except the player's meals. But to be sure each player has money for meals, I will distribute that money back to the player in increments for breakfast, lunch, and/ or dinner. Of course, once in Pensacola, we will do our best to pool our monies to purchase groceries and other items for sandwiches and team meals. We will also look to negotiate with reputable restaurants to get group discounts. Whatever money is not used by the player will be returned to him on the final day of the trip. Any other expenses are the responsibility of each player.

The team will meet at Coral Reef High on Sunday March 28th at 7AM in order to board the bus and depart by 8AM. I do encourage players to pack some snacks for the ride. We will of course, stop for breakfast, lunch and probably dinner, before arriving in Pensacola.

**We have arranged to stay at the Travelodge Inn & Suites- 6950 Pensacola Blvd, Pensacola, FL (850) 473-0222.**

The team, coaches, and drivers have already reserved rooms for the stay. Parents who wish to stay at the same venue will need to call there for reservations. Be sure to state that your with the Coral Reef High School baseball team and you should get a **discounted rate of \$49/night plus tax.** Of course, parents are welcome to make their own lodging arrangements elsewhere.

I am currently seeking permission to offer seating on the team bus to any parent who is **Level 2** cleared on the volunteer list with Miami-Dade County Public Schools. In order to help us defray the cost of the bus rental that would require a \$100 fee for round trip transportation made ***payable to Barracuda Diamond Club, Inc.*** Those who do elect to ride with us must be listed on the official chaperone field trip list and must be level 2 clearance. We will probably offer no more than 12 seats. So it would be a first come first serve situation.

We will begin play on Monday, March 29 ( the game schedule is not yet available). There will be one day off during the week and we will arrange site seeing and other team activities, including a practice session). The last game should be played on Friday, April 2, so we will stay the night and depart for Miami very early Saturday morning and should arrive home safely at approximately 10PM Saturday, April 3.
